PREFACE.

The Weavers' Society of Anderston was instituted on 3rd November, 1738, by an informal Document known as "The Contract of Society." It was signed by its 22 Founders, who were all then Weavers in Anderston. At that date Anderston was a Village, separated a short distance from the City of Glasgow, and was celebrated for its weaving industry. It was with the object of protecting that industry that the Society had its origin. It was not until the year 1824 that Anderston was constituted by Royal Charter into a Burgh of Barony, and two years later received by Act of Parliament the powers of a Police and Municipal Burgh. The Founders accordingly adopted the only course which was available to them at the time to protect their industry, which evidently was being seriously affected by the introduction of unskilled labour. Had they been carrying on their trade in a Burgh of Barony or other similarly constituted community the probability is that they would have received Royal recognition in common with other craftsmen of that period, in the form of a Charter of Incorporation empowering them to insist upon all professing their craft being properly qualified and skilled tradesmen. Isolated as they were from all protective privileges, the Founders could only act as they did, and it testifies to the loyalty and support which has in past years been shown by its members that the original Contract, under which the Society sprung into existence, has never been challenged as otherwise than binding. The early Minutes of the Society's proceedings form interesting reading, as testifying to the earnestness shown by the members in the affairs of the craft, the strict adherence to the rules, and the fairness displayed, not only in the conduct of the Society's business so far as it pertained

to the industry itself, but in the admission of new members and in the granting of assistance to its dependants. They further bear evidence of the orderly conduct insisted upon at all meetings of the Society, the respect shown to the Oversman and his Masters, and the penalties which followed any breach of its rules or attempt to tamper with or ignore its voluntarily imposed rights and privileges.

As in the case of many similar Societies, the capital funds originated from the small contributions of its entrants and members. These were made in merks Scots, and as years passed gradually accumulated—no doubt due to economic management and to the zeal in the Craft's affairs shown by its members—to a sum which enabled the first Capital investment to be made in the year 1764. This investment took the form of the purchase of a plot of ground fronting what was then known as the King's Highway—now Argyle Street—"together with the dwelling-house built thereon and yard adjoining." The proceedings of the Society at this period of its history and as disclosed by the Minutes are interesting. On 16th October, 1764, the members of the Society met and authorised the investment. The following is an excerpt from the Minute of their meeting:—

"After legal warning given for that effect met here the
"Oversman Masters and a great number of the Members of
"the Societie, Then the Oversman acquainted them That
"John Logan having a House to be exposed to Sale by publick
"Roup next Week, The design of calling this meeting was to
"have their minds whether they would think it proper or not
"to lay out the Societies money on the purchase of said
"House, if it could be got at a reasonable & advantageous
"rate for the behoof of the Societie.

"Thereupon the Vote was stated Purchase or Not—It was
"carried by a great plurality of voices Purchase and at the
"same time impowered the oversman and masters to bid for
"it at the Roup, or make a private Bargain for it betwixt and
"the Roup day if they could hit it to the advantage of the
"Societie."

This resolution was, a few days later, further considered at a

meeting of the Oversman and his Masters, when the former was empowered to treat with the seller privately and, as the minute discloses, to—

"Buy said House as low as possible & at the same time
"gave him power to give any sum for it, not exceeding one
"hundred & Sixty one pounds Sterling money."

At a later meeting of the Masters a minute bears that—

"The Oversman reported that he had bought the house
"for behoof of the Societie at the price of one hundred and
"Sixty Pounds Sterling money which was the lowest he could
"bring it to, whereupon the Meeting Did approve of the
"Oversman Diligence in this affair and of said purchase."

No doubt the object of this purchase was to provide a suitable meeting-place in which to conduct the Society's business. John Logan's house was situated in the King's Highway at the junction of that thoroughfare with the street now known as North Street. It was thus in the heart of Anderston, and may be fairly assumed to have formed the meeting-place of the Founders, although the old Minutes make no reference to it further than disclosing the meetings to have been held in "Anderstoun."

On 3rd February, 1769, the members of the Society passed the following resolution, viz.:—

"That it would be for the advantage of the Society that a
"back house were bulded upon there back ground intended
"for a ten or twelve loom shop, and repaired above or not as
"the managers shall find most for the advantage of the
"Society, the society being warned for that purpose and the
"roll being Called and vots marked, it caried by a great
"majoriety buld, wherefor they did and hearby do enact
"that a House be bulded upon there back ground, in such a
"way as the Managers for the time shall find most for the
"benifect of the poor of the Society, and the Society impoure
"there managers to proceed to said bulding with all
"convenente speed."

The price paid for this "back ground" seems to have been Fifty Pounds Sterling. The purchase of this ground, as well as Logan's House, were made in the name of "The Community of

Weavers," the name under which the Society at that date was known. The "Community" held both properties until 1852, when, under decree of the Court of Session, they were adjudged the property of "The Weavers' Society of Anderston," and a Charter of Confirmation was issued in their favour by the Incorporation of Tailors in Glasgow, their immediate lawful superiors in the lands. At a later period two further plots of ground were purchased, and it is on these four plots, all of which are contiguous, that there has, in recent years, been erected large and substantial buildings now occupied as warehouses, shops, offices, etc. It is from this property that the Society at the present time derives its main source of revenue.

It was not until the year 1902 that the Society's importance amongst the benevolent institutions of the City of Glasgow came to be recognised. With an ever-increasing capital stock, the desirability of greater security became apparent. No guarantee could be given that the loyalty which had been shown to the original crude Contract of Constitution, which was by no means a legally-binding document, would be always adhered to by its Members, and, accordingly, the desirability of obtaining a Royal Charter of Incorporation was recognised. On a Petition, supported by many leading citizens in Glasgow, being presented to his late Majesty King Edward explaining the Society's usefulness as a benevolent Institution, a grant of Royal Charter was issued on 25th October, 1902. This was followed by a Supplementary Royal Charter granted by his present Majesty King George on 14th April, 1926, under which it became lawful to extend the bounty of the Society to unmarried daughters and maiden sisters of deceased Members which up to that date was available only to decayed Members and their widows.

By the passing of the Act of Parliament of 14th May, 1846—an Act under which all exclusive privileges and rights of trading in Scotland were abolished—the original object of the Society ceased to exist. From that date, however, the Society has retained its personality and still continues to carry on the benevolent purposes which, amongst others, the Founders had in view in 1738. The weaving industry of Anderston has long ceased to exist, its place

being now taken by the great and important industries of ship-building and engineering. The situation of the old Burgh Lands with its frontage to the River Clyde readily adapted itself to works of this character, and in the rapid development of the district, which set in towards the latter half of last century, the old Burgh landmarks gradually disappeared, and, indeed, little if anything now remains to indicate the sites of the weavers' workshops or the houses of the Founders of the Society.

The Directors, who now take the place of the original Founders, have endeavoured, as far as possible, to retain for the Society its interest in the locality. They welcome into membership the representatives of those who, in former days, were associated with the old Village and Burgh, and who no doubt not only recognised its importance as a great business centre, but looked forward to the time when it would become part of the City of Glasgow.

Since the institution of the Society the Byelaws, Rules, and Regulations have periodically been altered and amended by resolutions of the Members so as to meet the necessities of the times. It is under the Byelaws, etc., approved by the Members in 1901 and adopted by them at the first Statutory Meeting of the Society held on 20th November, 1902, shortly after receipt of the Royal Charter of Incorporation, that the Society's affairs have been conducted to this date. Recently it was felt, however, by the Directors that these Byelaws, etc., had become antiquated, and that for greater efficiency in the management of the Society's affairs, a new set of Byelaws, embodying the various changes which in the interval had taken place, was necessary. The following Byelaws, Rules, and Regulations of the Society were accordingly prepared and approved of by the Members at a meeting held on the fifth day of August, 1926, and declared to be the Byelaws of the Society to be observed in future.

RIGHTS, BYELAWS, RULES, AND REGULATIONS.

I. RIGHTS.

The Society shall be called "THE WEAVERS' SOCIETY OF ANDERSTON," and its objects are declared to be the benevolent assistance of such of its Members, their Widows, and others hereinafter mentioned as may be in reduced circumstances.

The Members of the Society have power, in accordance with its Charters, to make Byelaws for the regulation of its affairs.

II.—MEMBERSHIP.

Applicants for admission, if otherwise qualified, may be proposed at any Meeting of the Directors, and may forthwith be admitted or rejected by a majority of votes. No new Members shall be admitted at the Annual Meeting of the Society.

No person shall be admitted a Member of the Society unless a British subject and in apparent good bodily health at the time of his application, and resident or carrying on business in the District, formerly known as the Village or Burgh of Anderston, or in the Lands of Finnieston or neighbourhood thereof. It shall, however, be in the power of the Directors to admit any applicant who may desire to join from motives of philanthropy, and who may be above a probability of requiring relief from the funds.

Should a Member admitted after 14th April, 1926, cease to be a British subject, he shall thereupon *ipso facto* cease to be a Member of the Society, and shall forfeit for himself and his dependents all rights of membership and claims to relief from the funds, and the name of any such Member shall be removed from the Roll.

Any Member declared or found by two-thirds of the Members present at any Meeting to have been guilty of wilfully misappropriating the funds of the Society or being found guilty of an offence against the Laws of the Realm, shall be expelled

therefrom and his name erased from the Society's Roll of Members without prejudice to the right of the Society to proceed against such party in terms of law.

III.—ENTRY MONEY

The fee or entry money payable by—

(a) A Son or son-in-law of a Member shall be £7 7s.

(b) A Stranger shall be - - - - - £21.

Until the entry money is paid to the Treasurer, the applicants' names shall not be enrolled, nor shall they be entitled to vote or otherwise interfere in the affairs of the Society.

IV.—OFFICE-BEARERS.

The management of the Society shall be vested in the following Office-Bearers, who shall form the Board of Management and be known as "The Directors," namely (a) the Preses, (b) the Preses of the immediately preceding year, (c) the Treasurer, (d) nine Directors, all of whom shall be elected as provided for under Rule XI., and (e) such number of Life Directors, not exceeding four, as may be elected to fill that office.

In the event of the office of Preses becoming vacant through death, resignation, disqualification, bankruptcy or otherwise, the Directors in office shall have power to appoint a former Preses of the Society to fill the vacancy for the unexpired period of the year in which such vacancy may occur.

In the event of the office of Treasurer becoming vacant through the like causes, the Directors shall have power to nominate one of their own number to fill the vacancy for the unexpired period of the year in which such vacancy may occur.

In the event of a vacancy occurring in the office of Director during the course of the year, through the like causes or the appointment to the office of Treasurer of one of their number in terms of the paragraph immediately preceding, the remaining Directors, along with the Preses and Treasurer, shall have power to appoint any duly qualified Member of the Society to fill the vacancy, but such Member so appointed to the office of Director shall only hold office until the ensuing Annual Meeting of the Society.

In the event of a Director who does not fall to retire by ordinary rotation in accordance with Rule XI. being elected to the office of Preses or Treasurer at the Annual Meeting, a Member of the Society shall be elected to fill the vacancy, but shall hold office only for the period such Director or Directors would have otherwise held office.

No Member of the Board of Management shall be eligible for election to any office of profit under the Board.

V.—PRESES.

No Member of the Society shall be entitled to hold the office of Preses until the lapse of two years after his date of entry.

VI.—LATE PRESES.

The Preses on demitting office at the Annual Meeting of the Society shall be entitled to hold office as a Director *ex officio*, but for one year only, and shall be known as the Late Preses. He shall not be eligible for nomination as an ordinary Director until the expiry of two years after demitting office as Late Preses.

VII.—TREASURER.

No Member of the Society shall be eligible to hold the office of Treasurer who has not during the year immediately previous held the office of Director. The Treasurer shall, on entering on his office, find security for his intromissions to the extent of £200 with an approved Guarantee Society, the expenses and premium attending which shall be paid from the funds of the Society. On his expiry of office the Treasurer shall submit a printed Abstract of his intromissions embracing a statement of the revenue and expenditure during his year of office, which Abstract shall be duly audited by the Society's Auditor and examined by the Directors at the Statutory Meeting in July. After approval, the print of the Abstract shall be sent to each Member of the Society for submission to the Annual Meeting.

VIII.—LIFE AND HONORARY DIRECTORS.

It shall be competent at the Annual Meeting of the Society to elect Directors for life, but the number of such Directors shall not exceed four. The person or persons so elected must have previously held the office of Preses. Life Directors on being elected shall have all the powers and privileges of a Director and shall be entitled to sit at all meetings of the Board called for the purpose of transacting the affairs of the Society.

It shall also be competent at the Annual Meeting of the Society to elect from the Roll of Members, Honorary Directors, but the number of such Directors shall not exceed fifteen. Honorary Directors shall hold their appointment for such period as the Society may from time to time think proper. The powers, duties and responsibilities of Honorary Directors shall from time to time be determined by the Board of Management. They shall not, however, as such, be Members of the Board, and shall only take an active part in the administration of the Society's affairs when required by the Directors.

IX.—SECRETARY.

The Secretary shall be appointed at the Annual Meeting of the Society. The Secretary must be a member of the legal profession, and if not a Member of the Society shall undertake to apply for admission and be admitted within six months of his appointment.

It shall be the duty of the Secretary to attend personally or by his representative, all Meetings of the Society and Directors; to take and keep in order regular Minutes of the business transacted at all Meetings. He shall act as the custodian of the securities and title deeds of the Society, the Minute and other Books. He shall keep a regular set of books into which shall be entered all transactions pertaining to the affairs of the Society, which books shall be brought to an annual balance as at 30th June in each year and shall be reported upon by the Auditors of the Society.

The Secretary shall receive for his services such salary as may from time to time be fixed by the Directors.

X.—AUDITOR.

The Auditor shall be appointed at the Annual Meeting of the Society.

The Auditor must be a member of the Institute of Accountants and Actuaries in Glasgow.

It shall be the duty of the Auditor from time to time, and as often as he thinks proper, to call for exhibition of the Society's books, and to investigate the entries therein. He shall complete his Annual Audit at least 14 days before the Annual Meeting, and shall issue a certificate, a copy of which shall be appended to the printed Abstract.

The Auditor shall receive for his services such remuneration as the Directors may appoint.

XI.—ELECTION OF OFFICE-BEARERS.

The Office-Bearers of the Society shall be elected at the Annual Meeting in August.

The Preses shall hold office for one year and be elected by the vote of the Members from amongst their number and must have previously held the office of Director.

The Treasurer shall hold office for one year and be elected by the vote of the Members from amongst the Directors in office for the year immediately preceding.

The Preses in office for the immediately preceding year shall sit as a Director *ex officio*.

The remaining nine Directors shall be elected by the vote of the Members, and of these, three shall retire annually and by rotation, but shall be eligible for re-election.

XII.—MEETINGS OF THE SOCIETY.

The whole Members of the Society shall meet annually on the first Thursday of August in each year for the purpose of (1) considering the Financial Statement of Accounts; (2) electing to office the Preses, Treasurer, Directors, and other Office-Bearers; and (3) transacting any other business of the Society.

A majority of votes at all Meetings shall determine the points submitted.

It shall always be in the power of the Preses or any three Directors to cause the Secretary to call a Special Meeting at any time during the year.

All Meetings of the Society shall be convened by the Secretary, whom failing from any cause whatsoever, by the Preses or Treasurer, and shall be by circular addressed to the Members at their last known address and by at least one advertisement in *The Glasgow Herald* or other recognised local newspaper. At least 48 hours' notice shall be given of all Meetings of the Society.

At all Meetings of the Society, twelve Members, including the Preses, Late Preses, Treasurer, and Members of the Board of Directors, shall form a quorum.

XIII.—MEETINGS OF DIRECTORS.

The Board of Management shall meet upon the first Friday of each of the months of November, February, and May, and in July, within eight days after the closing of the Society's Accounts on 30th June, for conducting the Society's business.

It shall always be in the power of the Preses or Treasurer to cause the Secretary to convene a Meeting of Directors on any urgent business requiring immediate attention, on 48 hours' notice.

At all Meetings of Directors five shall form a quorum.

The Preses shall preside at all Meetings of the Directors; whom failing, the Preses for the preceding year; whom both failing, a Director chosen by the Meeting.

XIV.—FUNDS.

The funds of the Society shall be held for purposes of a strictly benevolent nature, for the benefit of such of its Members, their widows, and others as may be in reduced circumstances.

The Directors shall have power to invest the funds of the Society in the purchase of lands, houses, feu-duties or ground annuals, or in first loans on good heritable security, at the current rate of interest prevailing at the time, and to vary the investments so often as they may think proper. The Directors shall also have power to invest the funds of the Society in any investment authorised by Statute under the Trust (Scotland) Acts. No funds shall be lent on personal security. All investments shall be taken in the name of the Preses, Treasurer, and Secretary for the time being and their successors in office, for behoof of the Society.

The Directors may, with the approbation of the Members, contribute from the funds of the Society towards any of the great Infirmaries or Institutions of the City of Glasgow or towards any National Benevolent Scheme instituted for the relief of suffering. In no case shall such contributions exceed, in any one year, the sum of £50.

XV.—SEAL.

The Seal of the Society shall be kept at the office of the Secretary, and shall only be used in connection with matters strictly pertaining to the affairs of the Society and by authority of the Directors.

XVI.—PENSIONS.

Pensions shall be granted only to Members and their widows who are in necessitous circumstances. It shall not be competent to award relief, either temporary or permanent, to a Member or his widow until at least five years after the Member's entry, and in no event shall more than one pension or precept be awarded in respect of the entry through which such pension or precept is made.

On the death of a pensioner, the Treasurer may in cases of need make an allowance towards funeral expenses, but in no case shall the amount exceed £5. In cases of very urgent need, the Directors may grant financial assistance to the unmarried daughter or maiden sister of a deceased Member. Such assistance shall take the form of a precept—the amount of which shall not exceed the maximum pension payable to the widow of a Member, and shall be made either in one sum or in instalments as the Directors may see fit.

The Directors shall be the sole judges of the right of relief and amount to be afforded, and in case of any difference of opinion among the Directors present, such difference of opinion shall be determined by a majority of votes.

No Member of the Society, his widow or other dependant, shall be entitled to demand relief, such relief being entirely voluntary on the part of the Directors, and to be given or withheld at pleasure. In no one year shall the Directors be entitled to spend in relief, or charity of any kind, more than five-sixths of the net annual income arising from the Capital Stock of the Society.

All applications for relief shall be made upon a printed form to be supplied by the Secretary, which form shall be signed by the applicant and shall give a full reply to the information asked. Applications for pensions may be considered and dealt with at the first Meeting of Directors following the receipt of the application. The Directors shall not be bound to assign any reason for the granting or refusal of relief.

Any Member receiving relief from the funds of the Society shall not be entitled to vote at any of the Meetings until he shall have reimbursed the sum or sums, but without interest, advanced to him.

In the event of a widow on the Pension Roll marrying again, she shall, from and after such marriage, forfeit all claim to the pension voted to her and all interest in the funds of the Society, and no widow shall be entitled to more than one allowance from the funds although she may have been the widow of more than one Member in succession.

A pensioner, male or female, on leaving this country for permanent residence abroad, shall, irrespective of his or her circumstances, forfeit all right to relief from the funds of the Society.

XVII.—VOTING.

No Member shall be entitled to vote whose name does not appear on the Society's Roll of Members.

The Chairman at all Meetings shall not only have a deliberative, but a casting vote, on all questions of equality.

Voting may be either by a show of hands or by voting papers supplied by the Secretary.

The Secretary at all elections shall act as returning officer, and shall have power to appoint such deputed as may be necessary. At no Meetings, either of the Society or the Directors, shall voting by proxy be permitted.

XVIII.—VISITATION OF PENSIONERS.

The pensioners shall be visited by the Directors either by themselves or along with such Members of the Society as the

Directors may appoint at least once every three years. The Directors may from time to time make such alterations in the payment of pensions as they may think expedient—the object being to ensure that sums so awarded are applied by the recipients in a proper manner and not wastefully expended.

XIX.—ALTERATION OF BYELAWS.

The foregoing Rules are hereby declared to be the fundamental Rules and Byelaws of the Society.

No alteration or amendment shall be made, nor shall any new Byelaw be adopted, unless notice shall be given at the Annual or any *pro re nata* Meeting of the Society at least three months prior to the Meeting of the Society at which the subject falls to be disposed of, and no new Rule or Byelaw shall be adopted or alteration made without the consent of a majority of the Members present at the Meeting convened for the special purpose of considering the amendment or alteration.

ROYAL CHARTER OF INCORPORATION.

Edward III. by the Grace of God OF THE UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND IRELAND AND OF THE BRITISH DOMINIONS BEYOND THE SEAS KING DEFENDER OF THE FAITH.

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME GREETING :

Whereas James Anderson Preses George Bell Treasurer Robert Reid Penman Ex-Preses and John Smeaton, John Clark, Joseph Taylor, James Lyon, William Baillie Hair, John Struthers, John Craig, William Stuart Service, John Miller Reid, James Ferguson, Robert Barclay Shaw, Hugh Alexander, William White, Daniel Wilkie, John M'Lea Wilkinson, John Muirhead and George Scott Hendry Directors and Joseph Macintyre Taylor Secretary all of the WEAVERS' SOCIETY OF ANDERSTON now included within the boundaries of the City of Glasgow have by their humble Petition in name of themselves and as acting for and representing the whole other members of the said Society whose names are entered in the Roll of the members of that Society represented to us that for nearly two centuries past the members of the said Society have been and now are united into a Society called "The Weavers' Society of Anderston" under certain rules and regulations established by themselves for promoting and protecting their industry and for managing their affairs and for raising a fund for the support of their poor and decayed members and their widows. THAT the said Society have during that period been in the use of electing one of their own number to be their Preses and another to be Treasurer of their funds and also of making rules for protecting and increasing and improving those funds and for managing the affairs of their Craft as Weavers and as protected by Law prior

to the Act 9 Vict. C. 17 by which Act inclusive privileges in the exercise of trades and handicrafts were abolished but the objects of all Incorporations in all other respects were preserved and since that time the Society has existed and been carried on for the benevolent purpose of increasing their funds and applying the same for the support of their poor and decayed brethren and their widows as well as for regulating generally their business affairs : AND WHEREAS by economy and good management the said Society have raised a considerable fund for the support of their decayed members and widows and it would be highly beneficial to the Petitioners if the said Society was incorporated with powers to consolidate the mode of management in use in times past and to establish further rules and regulations and bye-laws for supporting their poor or decayed members and widows and when necessary for making more suitable provision for the better conducting of the affairs of the said Society for the benefit of the whole members thereof and for the public at large. The Petitioners therefore humbly prayed that We would be graciously pleased to grant them OUR ROYAL CHARTER ratifying approving and confirming the institution of the said Society and the establishment of their funds and Common Stock and incorporating the Petitioners and their successors by the name of THE WEAVERS' SOCIETY OF ANDERSTON or by any other proper name and with such powers privileges and authorities and under such regulations as are usually given to bodies politic and corporate and as to Us in Our great wisdom should seem meet. We having taken the said Petition into Our Royal Consideration and being willing to give all proper encouragement to so useful and charitable an Institution : Therefore We in compliance with the said humble request and by virtue of Our Royal Prerogative and of Our special grace certain knowledge and mere motion DO RATIFY APPROVE and CONFIRM the institution of the said Society and the establishment of the Funds and Common Stock of the same : And have GRANTED CONSTITUTED DECLARED and APPOINTED as We by these presents GRANT CONSTITUTE DECLARE and APPOINT that the said Preses Treasurer Ex-Preses Directors and Secretary before-named and the whole other members of the Society whose names are duly entered in the Roll of the Society as members thereof and

such other persons as shall be hereafter duly admitted and contribute to the funds of the Society shall be called one Corporation and Body Politic by the name and style of "THE WEAVERS' SOCIETY OF ANDERSTON" and that they and their successors shall for ever hereafter have a perpetual succession for the purpose of better and more effectually managing directing ordering and appointing in all matters and things respecting the said Society and the funds thereunto belonging. And We for the purposes aforesaid DO by these presents MAKE ERECT CREATE CONSTITUTE and ESTABLISH the said James Anderson and the other persons before-named (and such other persons who shall have been duly admitted and shall contribute to the funds of the Society in manner aftermentioned) into a Corporation and Body Politic and Corporate for ever by the name and style aforesaid: With power to them or to the majority of them to manage direct order and appoint in all matters and things touching and respecting the said Society its government estates funds and other affairs and concerns: And that the said Society by the name and style aforesaid may be able and capable in law to have purchase receive hold possess enjoy and retain in perpetuity or otherwise lands heritages tenements and hereditaments of what kind quality or nature soever: And likewise to lend money upon heritable or personal securities and to hold goods and chattels and receive and hold donations and legacies: And also to sell impignorate wadset and renounce any of the lands tenements or other heritable subjects or rights already purchased or acquired for the behoof of the said Society or which at any time hereafter may be purchased or acquired by the said Society: And to give and grant leases tacks or assedations of the said lands tenements or other heritable subjects: And to feu out the same by way of perpetual location for a competent feu duty or ground annual: And also to collect uplift receive and discharge all debts and sums of money heritable or moveable heretofore pertaining and indebted to the said Society: As also to sue and be sued plead and be impleaded defend and be defended in the name and style aforesaid in whatever Courts and places and before whomsoever judges justices or other officers in all actions pleas suits complaints account matters and demands whatsoever in such manner and form as any of our subjects able

and capable in law or any other body politic or corporate may or can: And also to have and hold a Common Seal for authenticating the deeds and other writings of the said Society and that it may be lawful for them and their successors to break or change the said Seal or to make and adopt another from time to time as to them or the majority of them shall seem expedient which Seal shall be kept by their Secretary who shall attend with the same or cause to be attended with at all meetings where it shall be required. And for the better and more easy management of the affairs and business of the said Society We for Ourselves Our heirs and successors hereby Order and Appoint a Preses of Society Board of 16 Directors Secretary and other necessary officers for the said Society to be chosen and appointed in manner hereinafter mentioned. And that the first General Meeting of the said Society be held on the second Thursday after this Charter shall pass the Seal appointed to be used in Scotland in place of the Great Seal thereof and the second General Meeting of the said Society be held on the first Thursday of the month immediately following: And that there be held one General Meeting of the said Society in every year thereafter upon the first Thursday of August at such place or places and hour or hours as the Preses and other Directors of the Society shall from time to time appoint: And that the Preses and Members of the Society shall and may have full power and authority at the said first General Meeting and thereafter at the General Meeting in August yearly to elect the said Preses Treasurer Directors Secretary and other necessary officers of the Society for such indefinite or definite length of time as the majority shall think fit and others in their room again to elect: And that the Preses and Treasurer shall in the ordinary management of the funds of the Society advise with and consult the said Directors. And We do hereby grant POWER and AUTHORITY to the Preses of the said Society for the time being at his pleasure or as often as their affairs may require the same upon forty-eight hours' notice to the other members to summon a meeting of the said Society and that the said Preses be entitled to preside at all meetings of the said Society and to have therein both a deliberative and a casting vote in every question upon an equality of voices among the members present provided nevertheless that the said Preses shall have no

negative upon calling of meetings of the Society but in case of his absence or refusal so to do that it may be lawful for the MEMBERS OF THE SOCIETY TO CALL MEETINGS IN SUCH WAY AND MANNER AND ACCORDING TO SUCH RULES as by the majority of their number may from time to time be enacted and appointed and that such meetings may have power to choose one of their number to preside as Chairman *pro re nata*. And we do hereby farther DIRECT ORDER and APPOINT that all purchases to be made by the Society or money to be lent by them shall be by the order and direction of a majority of the Members present at any of the said general meetings or special meetings called for the purpose and that the Bond and other securities shall be taken in the name of the Preses Treasurer and Secretary of the said Society and to their successors in office for the use and behoof of the Society. And we do hereby DIRECT ORDER and APPOINT that an annual account of the estates and funds of the said Society and of the receipts and outgoings shall be made up by the Treasurer and laid before the General Meeting in the month of August yearly for examination and approbation: And that the said Treasurer's books and accounts shall be produced at the General Meetings in the month of August as well as at all other Special and General Meetings when required for the inspection of the Preses and other members of the Society. And We farther WILL and DECLARE that no person shall be entitled or be qualified to become a member of the said Society if under the age of 14 or above the age of 45 nor unless in apparent bodily health at the time of application or resident in the Burgh of Anderston or in the neighbourhood thereof or others who desire to become members from motives of philanthropy and unless such person be of good character and deportment and every way qualified to become a member of the said Society: And that such person being reported in all respects so qualified and paying the accustomed fees after-mentioned shall be admitted a member of the Society and shall receive a diploma in writing under the hands of the Preses Treasurer and Secretary for the time being and the Seal of the said Society: And shall pay such fees for his admission as are then usual and prestable and engage to contribute to the funds of the Society along with the other members: And such

persons so admitted members shall continue members so long as they shall observe and comply with the rules and regulations of the Society already made and enacted or hereafter to be made and enacted. And farther We do hereby for Ourselves Our heirs and successors GIVE and GRANT to the Preses and members of the said Society and their successors full power and authority in General Meetings assembled from time to time to constitute ORDAIN AND MAKE SUCH AND SO MANY BYELAWS CONSTITUTIONS ORDERS AND ORDINANCES as they or the major part of them then and there present shall judge proper and necessary for the better government and direction of the said Society and improvement and distribution of the funds thereof and to alter or annul the said byelaws constitutions orders and ordinances or any of them or any of the former acts and regulations of said Society heretofore made to alter or annul as the said Preses and members so assembled or the major part of them then present shall see requisite: And to cause to be duly observed and kept all such byelaws constitutions orders ordinances and alterations so as aforesaid to be made: PROVIDED ALWAYS that the same be noways contrary or repugnant to the Laws of the Realm nor to the tenor hereof. And farther We of Our special grace certain knowledge and mere motion have GRANTED and CONFIRMED and by the tenor hereof for ourselves our heirs and successors GRANT and CONFIRM to the said Society all estates sums of money rights interests profits benefits advantages powers privileges and other matters and things whatsoever by the said Society or by any members of the same for the use and behoof thereof heretofore had received enjoyed exercised been entitled unto made or done to HAVE HOLD RECEIVE and ENJOY to them and their successors and to the said Society for ever and in as ample and beneficial a manner to all intents and purposes as the said Society or any of its members for its use and behoof heretofore held enjoyed and exercised the same. And We do for Ourselves Our heirs and successors DECLARE that this Charter shall be in and by all things valid and effectual in law according to the true intent and meaning of the same and shall be taken construed and adjudged in the most favourable and beneficial manner for the best advantage of the said Society notwithstanding any

misrecital defect uncertainty or imperfection therein. And We do for Ourselves Our heirs and successors COVENANT GRANT and AGREE to and with the said Society and Corporation or Body Politic and their successors that We Our heirs and successors shall and will from time to time and in all times hereafter upon the humble suit or request of the said Corporation or Body Politic and their successors GIVE and GRANT unto them all such farther and other privileges authorities matters and things for rendering more effectual this our Grant according to the true intent and meaning of these presents which We or they can or may lawfully Grant and as shall be reasonably advised and devised by the Counsel learned in the Law of the said Corporation or Body Politic for the time being and shall be approved of by the Lord Advocate or Solicitor-General in Scotland of Us Our heirs or successors in our or their behalf.

In Witness Whereof We have ordered the Seal appointed by the Treaty of Union to be kept and made use of in place of the Great Seal of Scotland to be appended hereto. Given at our Court at Saint James's the Twenty-fifth day of October, in the year One Thousand Nine hundred and two and in the second year of Our Reign.

SUPPLEMENTARY CHARTER OF INCORPORATION.

George the Fifth, by the Grace of God OF THE UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND IRELAND AND OF THE BRITISH DOMINIONS BEYOND THE SEAS, KING, DEFENDER OF THE FAITH :

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL
COME : GREETING !

Whereas, the Weavers' Society of Anderston, which was instituted in the year 1738, was incorporated by Royal Charter of Incorporation granted by Our Royal Predecessor King Edward the Seventh, on the 25th day of October, 1902, and has continued to conduct its affairs and administer its funds for the benefit of the poorer members of its Craft, and their widows, strictly in accordance with the terms thereof and under certain Byelaws, Rules, and Regulations made from time to time and approved of by its members :

And Whereas it has been represented to us, by the humble Petition of the said Society, that for the more efficient management and regulation of its affairs and for the purpose of applying the income derived from its invested funds for the benefit of a wider class of beneficiaries, and otherwise maintaining its dignity as a charitable institution for the relief of its dependents and the whole members thereof, certain alterations on and additions to the powers conferred by its Royal Charter of Incorporation are desired, and an application has accordingly been made to Us by the said Petition to grant to the said Society a Supplementary Charter making such alterations on its constitution and giving it such additional powers as are hereinafter set forth :

Now Know Ye that We having taken the said Petition into our Royal consideration of our Royal Will and Pleasure and moved thereto by our Good Will to the said Society, and in order

to give all proper encouragement for the better administration and usefulness thereof for Ourselves and Our Heirs and Successors, in addition to and notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in the said Charter dated 25th October, 1902, are graciously pleased to Grant and Declare and Ordain as follows:—

1. The Board of Management of the Society shall consist of nine Ordinary Directors to be appointed by the Members of the Society, the Preses and Treasurer for the time, the Preses of the immediately preceding year, and not more than four Life Directors.

2. Such Life Directors shall be appointed by the remaining members of the Board of Management and shall hold office for life. On the death or resignation of any of the said Life Directors, the vacancy thus caused shall be filled up by the Board of Management in the same way as in the appointment of the original Life Directors.

3. The Members of the Society in General Meeting assemble shall have power to appoint from amongst their number Honorary Directors not exceeding fifteen in number to hold office for such period as the members of the Society may determine, but whose duties and responsibilities as Honorary Directors shall be defined by the Board of Management. Such Honorary Directors shall not, as such, be members of the Board of Management.

4. It shall be competent to admit into membership of the Society any person irrespective of age, provided such person be of good character, and in the opinion of the Board of Management for the time being otherwise suitable for admission, but no person shall be qualified for and admitted a member who is not both resident in the United Kingdom or the Irish Free State and also a British subject. Should a member admitted after the date of this Supplementary Charter cease to be a British subject he shall thereupon *ipso facto* cease to be a member of the Society, and shall forfeit for himself and his dependents all rights of membership and claims to relief from the funds, and the name of any such member shall be removed from the Roll.

5. It shall be lawful for the Society to grant relief from its funds to the unmarried sisters and unmarried daughters of past and present members, if in the opinion of the Board of Management the circumstances of such sisters and daughters warrant relief.

In Witness Whereof We have ordered the Seal appointed by the Treaty of Union to be kept and made use of in place of the Great Seal of Scotland to be appended hereto. Given at our Court at Windsor the Fourteenth day of April, One Thousand Nine hundred and twenty-six, in the sixteenth year of Our Reign.
