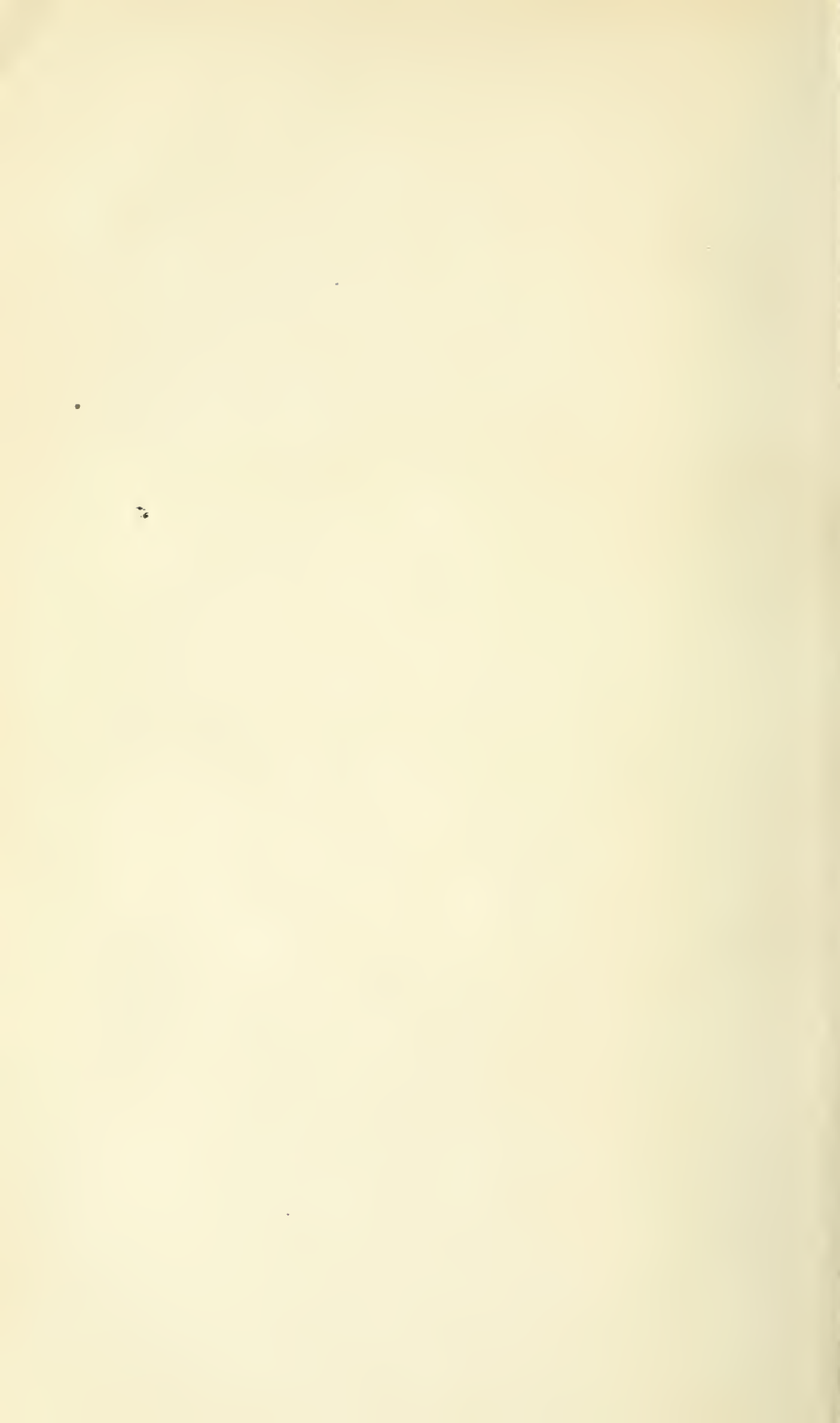

I. The Society shall continue to be called "THE WEAVERS' SOCIETY OF ANDERSTON," and its objects are declared to be the charitable aid of such of its Members and their Widows as may be reduced to destitute circumstances.

Title and objects
of Society.

II. Applicants for admission, if otherwise qualified, may be proposed at any quarterly or *pro re nata* Meeting of the Directors, and shall be admitted or rejected by a majority of votes at the following meeting; but at General Meetings of the Society applications for membership may be finally disposed of at once by a majority of votes of the Members present. The fee or entry money payable by a son or son-in-law of a Member, or by an apprentice indentured to a Member (a Weaver by trade), shall be £2, 2s. sterling, and the entrance fee payable by all others shall be £5, 5s., with the addition of 2s. per annum in the case of sons, sons-in-law, and apprentices, and of 5s. per annum in the case of all others, for each year such applicant shall exceed the age of thirty years at the date of their admission; and until the said fees are paid to the Treasurer, the applicant's name shall not be enrolled, nor shall he be entitled to vote or otherwise interfere in the affairs of the Society.

III. No person shall be admitted a Member of the Society under the age of fourteen or above the age of forty-five, nor unless in apparent bodily health at the time of application, or resident in the district formerly known as the Burgh of Anderston, or on the Lands of Finnieston, or in the neighbourhood thereof. It being, however, declared that it shall always be in the power of the Society or of the Master Court to admit to the Society any applicants, of whatever age and wherever residing.

who may desire to join the same from motives of philanthropy, and who may be above a present probability of ever needing relief from the funds of the Society, of which probability the Preses and Directors are hereby declared to be the sole judges.

IV. The management of the Society shall be vested in a Preses, Treasurer, and sixteen Masters or Directors, who shall form the Master Court, seven of whom shall form a quorum, and who shall be nominated and elected at the Annual General Meetings of the Society, as follows—viz., one of the four candidates named at the meeting appointed to be held in Rule VII., or in the event of any of the four candidates being absent, or in the event of no lect being named, from any cause, any one of the Directors for the preceding year shall be elected Preses, and one of the Members of the Master Court for the preceding year shall be elected Treasurer, and the Preses shall thereupon nominate four members; and the members present shall elect nine members as Directors or Members of the Master Court. The remaining Directors shall consist of the Preses and Treasurer for the preceding year, together with the candidate standing second in votes for the office of Preses, who are hereby declared Directors *ex officio*. It is in the option of the Directors, on any vacancy in the office of Preses occurring through death, resignation, or disqualification, either to elect one of the Directors for the year then current, or to call a General Meeting of the Society for the purpose—the party so elected being entitled to hold office until the next Annual Meeting.

It shall be competent to elect Honorary Directors for Life at the General Meetings of the Society, but the number of such Directors shall at no time exceed four, and the persons so elected must have previously held office as Directors.

Annual General

V. A General Meeting of the whole Members of the Society, convened by advertisement in any one of the Glasgow newspapers, shall be held annually on the first Friday of August in each year, for the purpose of electing the Preses, Treasurer, Directors, and other Office-bearers; of considering the proceedings of the Master Court during the year, and transacting

the extraordinary business of the Society; declaring that the majority of votes at all meetings, whether of the Society or the Master Court, shall determine the point submitted and voted on; the Preses, or, in his absence, the Chairman *pro tempore* having a casting as well as a deliberative vote; and at no meeting of the Directors, or the Society, shall votes by proxy be allowed.

VI. The Preses shall have the custody of the Box containing the Society's records or papers, and of the other *insignia* of office; and the keys of the said Box shall be held by the following parties as Key or Box Masters,—viz., the centre key by the Preses, the right hand key by the Treasurer, and the left hand key by the Director elected first in order by the Society, and the keys shall be delivered over to these parties at the Annual General Meeting.

VII. The Preses and Directors, constituting the Master Court, shall meet quarterly upon the first Friday of each of the months of November, February, May, and August respectively, for the purpose of conducting the Society's business. The Preses and Directors shall also meet ten free days before the Annual General Meeting of the Society, for the purpose of nominating four candidates for the office of Preses; and which nomination shall take place as follows,—one candidate shall be named by the Preses, or in his absence by the Chairman of the meeting, two by the Meeting, who, together with the candidate second in votes at the immediately preceding election of Preses, shall form the leet for the office of Preses for the ensuing year; and at this Meeting the Directors may appoint two of their number to audit the Treasurer's accounts for the current year; declaring, however, that it shall always be in the power of the Preses, or of any three Directors to cause the Clerk to call a *pro re nata* meeting at any time whatever—forty-eight hours' notice by circular of all Meetings of Directors being given by the Clerk.

vided elect a Clerk to keep the minutes and writs of the Society, who shall continue in office during the Society's pleasure, and who shall be paid for his services such a salary as may from time to time be fixed by the Society or by the Master Court; and the Society shall also at said meeting appoint an Officer, whose principal duty shall be to warn the Members and Directors to attend the meetings of the Society and Master Court, and to wait on the same, and such Officer shall continue in office during the Society's pleasure, and receive for his services such remuneration as may be fixed by the Master Court.

IX. Members receiving relief from the funds shall not be entitled to vote at any of the meetings of the Society; and Members who have received temporary relief at any time shall not be entitled to vote at the General Meeting next ensuing after such relief shall have been given, unless the same shall have been repaid to the Society.

Penalty for

X. Any Member declared or found by two-thirds of the Members present at any Meeting of the Master Court to have been guilty of wilfully embezzling or misappropriating the funds of the Society, shall be expelled therefrom, and his name erased out of the Society's Books, without prejudice to the right of the Society or of the Office-bearers thereof to proceed against such party in terms of Law.

XI. It shall not be competent for the Directors to award relief either temporary or permanent to any Member or Widow of a Member until three years after the date of such Member's entry; and in all cases the Members of the Master Court assembled at any Quarterly or *pro re nata* Meetings, shall be the sole judges of the right to, and amount of, the permanent or temporary relief to be afforded; and in case of any difference of opinion amongst the Directors present at such meeting, such difference of opinion shall be determined by a majority of votes; declaring that in no case shall any Member of the Society be entitled to demand relief, nor shall the Society be

bound to afford it—such relief being entirely voluntary on the part of the Society, and to be given or withheld at pleasure; and declaring that in no one year shall the Directors be entitled to spend in relief or charity of any kind more than the free annual income arising from the capital stock of the Society.

XII. The accounts of the Society shall be kept by the Treasurer, who shall prepare an account current of the whole cash transactions of the year, which shall be laid before the Preses and the Auditors to be appointed in terms of Rule VII., for the purpose of examining and reporting on the same to a Meeting of the old and new Master Courts, to be held annually on the last Friday of August; and which account current having been examined and approved of, shall, in evidence thereof, be docketed by the Preses, or in his absence by the Chairman for the time being, whereupon the Treasurer shall be discharged of his whole intromissions, and the books and accounts, together with any balance in his hands, shall be handed over to the new Treasurer in the presence of the Meeting; declaring that the Treasurer shall, from time to time, lodge in such bank as the Master Court may appoint the funds of the Society coming into his hands; and declaring that in order to facilitate the duties of the Treasurer, the Master Court shall have power to appoint a Factor to co-operate with him in collecting the rents of the heritable property of the Society, and shall award the Factor so appointed such remuneration as they from time to time may think necessary.

XIII. A sum not exceeding ten shillings shall be allowed from the funds of the Society to defray any expenses that may be incurred at each Meeting of the Directors.

XIV. The funds of the Society shall continue to be lent out on good heritable security, to the satisfaction of the majority of the Directors, at such interest as can be had, or laid out in the purchase of heritable subjects; and the rights and vouchers

shall be taken in name of the Managers of the Society for the time being, and the survivors or survivor of them, and the heirs of the survivors or survivor of them, in trust and for behoof of the Society; and the writings and other valuable documents of the Society shall be deposited in the Society's Box, or in such other safe custody as the Master Court may from time to time appoint.

Alteration
of Rules.

XV. The foregoing Rules are hereby declared to be the Fundamental Rules and Bye-Laws of the Society, and no alteration whatever shall be made thereon, unless proposed at an Annual General Meeting; and in the event of any such alteration being proposed, the motion for such alteration shall lie on the table until the next Annual General Meeting, when it shall be disposed of, and such alteration being approved of, shall be engrossed in the Minute-Book, and binding on all concerned; declaring that notice of such alteration shall be given in the advertisement calling the General Meeting.
